MAY COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Thursday 1st May 2003 is ELECTION DAY. All nomination papers had to be delivered to the Returning Officer at The Hollies, Midsomer Norton by 1st April 2003 and we wait with interest to discover how many Saltford residents have put their names forward to stand for Parish Councillor. Will there be more applicants than the eleven seats on Saltford Parish Council? If so, the choice is yours to vote for who you consider would best serve the interests of all in Saltford for the next four years.

Grateful thanks to all our current Parish Councilors for their regular attendance and input at the many Council and Committee meetings over the past four years.

CHANGE OF STREET NAME FOR CLEVERTON ROAD WEST

Many of you will be pleased to hear that there will be NO change of name. Many postcards, e-mails, telephone calls and indeed lengthy letters have been received on this subject expressing your views - thank you for all who responded - please accept this as your acknowledgement. It has been decided by Council to amend the present road plates to read "Claverton Road West leading to "Claverton Road" and "Claverton Road leading to Claverton Road West" as was done recently when confusion reigned at Uplands Road and Uplands Drive. I half expected a long list of alternative names but these never materialised - the one that did bring a chuckle was "Grange Road East" as it was suggested the value of the properties in Claverton Road West would rise sharply!

FOOTPATH CLOSURE EXTENDED

Works to the footpath BA27/43 from Bath Road across the railway bridge are taking longer than anticipated resulting in this footpath being closed until the end of June 2003.
