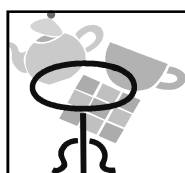

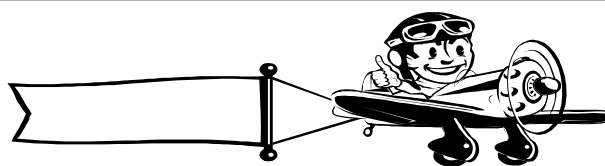

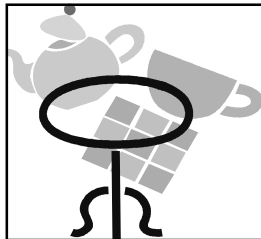

Planning application procedure for notifying neighbours

PARKING AT SALTFORD HALL

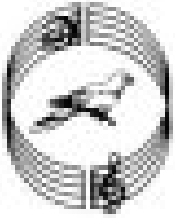


Calling all people who park their cars in the area of Saltford Hall when they use the Hall facilities.

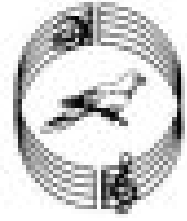
