Saltford Parish Council News

On behalf of the Councillors of Saltford Parish Council, we would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a very Happy Christmas and a Peaceful New Year

Possible Closure of Manor Road Toilets

By the time you read this, there will have been a public meeting in November (advertised on the Parish Council notice board) to discuss the possible closure of some public toilets in the B&NES area – those in Manor Road are on the hit list. A usage survey has recently been carried out by B&NES to determine the number of people who make use of these facilities as has an independent survey by MSS Marketing Research of Bristol. This Council's reaction was that, if the recent survey clearly demonstrated that the usage was not cost effective, then we would, very reluctantly, accept closure of these toilet facilities. However, prior to any closure taking place, we would expect the toilets in The Shallows to be refurbished with adequate road signage erected around the village and, when all has been completed, the Manor Road site should be closed and razed to the ground.

20 mph Speed Limit

It now looks as if the 20 mph speed limit destined for the High Street, Mead Lane and The Shallows and all roads off will not become effective until the New Year (NB we are not specifying which New Year!). Rest assured that your Parish Council are pushing for this to go ahead as quickly as possible as it is some years now since this was first proposed.

<u>Vandalism</u>

If you see or know of any vandalism taking place, ring 999. From reports that are constantly being fed into the Parish Council office, there is a lot going on at the moment and we need to put a stop to it. The cost to you, the rate payer, is enormous. For example, the recent damage to the Bus Shelters alone is worth a £1 a head on your rates.

'Slow Down' Road Signs

Even 'Slow Down' road signs have to be serviced, so we are reliably informed, which accounts for us not seeing their arrival in Saltford. We have changed the locations of the first two sites, having received numerous complaints from residents in Grange Road about speeding in that road. The signs will now be sited in Grange Road and in Norman Road, each for a fortnightly period, but no mention when they will be there other than 'soon'.

Environmental Committee

We only received one response to our request asking for ideas and concerns about matters currently affecting your village. The subject of our one response was 'rubbish' – well 'litter', to be honest. With the recent fall of leaves from trees, it has been a big problem for our two part-time sweepers and B&NES with their mechanical machines. It has certainly not been helped when paper litter is thoughtlessly abandoned instead of being placed in the many waste bins sited around the village.
