Remember to keep vehicle and house keys out of view in your home. A significant amount of vehicle crime is committed when car keys are stolen during burglaries. Do not leave valuables on display in your car. Keep items out of sight, and your vehicle locked.

# Recycling and waste collection at Christmas



## Collection changes over Christmas 2010 and New Year

Only residents whose usual collection day is **Monday** or **Tuesday** will be affected by the Christmas and New Year holiday collection changes.

### Recycling Centres – Holiday Arrangements

**Closed Sat 25, Sun 26, Mon 27 December 2010 and Sat 1 January 2011**

Usual opening times Monday – Friday 8am – 4.15pm

Weekends and bank holidays 8am – 3.45pm

(Please note: bank holiday closing times apply on Tuesday 28 December 2010 and Monday 3 January 2011)

### FREE Christmas Tree Collections

We'll collect your real tree for composting throughout January. If it is over 4ft tall, please cut it up so we can fit it into our vehicle. Please make sure you take off any decorations first (including the pot) and leave it out at the edge of your property so it is visible for collection on your garden waste collection day. To check your collection day please go to [www.bathnes.gov.uk](http://www.bathnes.gov.uk) and enter your post code or contact Council Connect.

### Festive tips for Recycling More

Did you know that the amount we throw away goes up by 10 per cent in three days over Christmas? This Christmas you will be able to recycle even more using your new weekly food waste collection. You can use your caddy for all cooked and raw food including turkey bones, stale mince pies, leftover sprouts and any foods past their 'use by' date, as well as any plate scrapings. If you are running low on the free compostable liners we gave, you can either use newspaper to line your food waste caddy, or buy more liners from local or online stockists. We have a list of these on our website [www.bathnes.gov.uk/foodwaste](http://www.bathnes.gov.uk/foodwaste)

Don't forget to make good use of your other recycling services ... white backed wrapping paper, all batteries (including rechargeable), aluminium foil and sweet tins can go in your green box for recycling. You can put cardboard, brown paper and greeting cards in your blue bag – but please make sure you take off any plastic and cut up or fold the card flat to fit into your blue bag so it will fit on our collection vehicle. Don't forget you can recycle any bulky cardboard packaging at our three Recycling Centres. Broken and unwanted electrical items such as hairdryers, fairy lights or electrical toys (in fact anything with a plug or batteries) can be taken to our Recycling Centres – they will be broken down and recycled into new items instead of ending up in a landfill site.

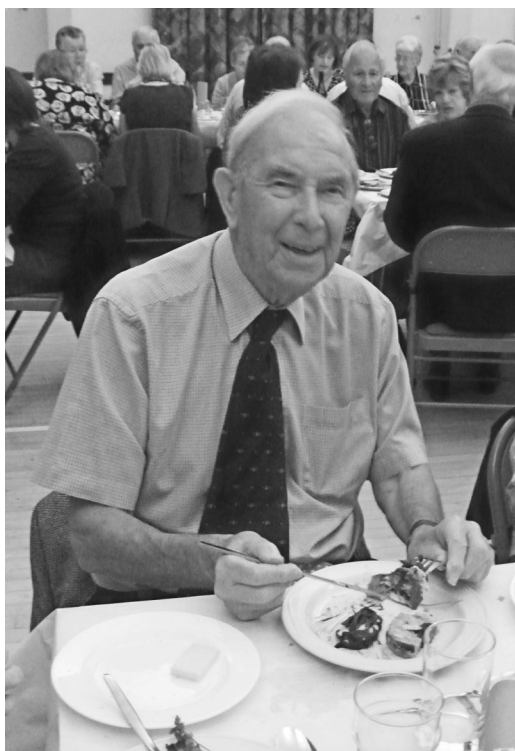

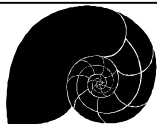
