The Citizens Advice Bureau B&NES has three bureau offices in Bath, Keynsham and Midsomer Norton. However, we feel that we are missing out on many people who would potentially seek our advice due to reasons such as mobility difficulties or lack of awareness. Hence we would like to try bringing CAB to those we suspect we may not presently reach to give advice

where needed on debt, benefits, employment, personal relations, housing etc. We will listen to the problems, try to resolve immediately but may need to follow up by phone or an appointment at a bureau. The service is, of course, completely free and confidential.

We have a specially converted blue van, clearly and prominently labelled as CAB, which can accommodate one client at interview and up to three others in a separate waiting area. It has its own generator, but we prefer to hook into a local electric source whenever possible to minimise noise and pollution.

Saltford Hall have kindly offered us the use of the parking in front of the hall, and connection to their electricity supply. They will also allow clients to wait inside the hall. This service is aimed solely at those living in Saltford.

We launched the service on Wednesday the 12th of October at the Hall, from 10am until 1pm. We will be visiting at the same times on every second and fourth Wednesday of each month except on public holidays. ie December 14, January 11, 25 and February 8 and 22 etc.. ### Computer owners warned about scammers

B&NES Council's Trading Standards team has received complaints about conmen posing as workers from Microsoft who encourage people to download software to fix a non-existent problem with their home PC. The software turns out to be malicious 'spyware' which allows criminals access to their personal data. Those targeted by the scam could also be urged to buy software by giving the caller their credit card details. The Council advises PC-owners to ignore unsolicited emails and phone calls requesting personal or financial information, and to be wary of anti-virus adverts which pop up on websites, or emails offering free scans to detect viruses. 
