Estimates have been sought, the cheapest of which is in excess of £16,000. This is a large amount of money and we are appealing to Saltford Community

CIVIC SERVICE

This year's Civic Service is being held at St Mary's Church at 6.30pm on Sunday evening 2nd February 2003. The Chairman, Councillor Maurice Short, extends a warm invitation to anyone who would like to support the Council at this service, after which light refreshments will be served.

PARISH MEETING

This year the Parish Meeting will be held at 6.30 pm in the Avon Room, Saltford Hall on 1st April 2003 and it is another opportunity for any Saltford residents to comment upon the work that is carried out by this Parish Council in the village. You will be able to put forward suggestions or ask questions on any matters relating to Saltford. Representatives of all local organisations have also been invited to give a short report of their activities over the past year.

MAY COUNCIL ELECTIONS

On 1st May 2003 all the parish and town council seats will be up for election. Are you interested in standing as a Saltford Parish Councillor? What is involved? You have me as Clerk for a start! Ah well you can't win them all! Meetings are twice monthly in the evenings at Saltford Hall. The term of office is 4 years and eleven Councillors can be

elected. Please seriously consider standing for election if you are interested and have ideas to improve your village.

CHANGE OF STREET NAME FOR CLAVERTON ROAD WEST

It has been suggested that due to the Emergency Services, Postal and Van deliveries being confused by the similarity of Claverton Road, and Claverton Road West we should consider changing the name of Claverton Road West. Mistakes by the Emergency Services could have fatal consequences and so 1 would like to hear from the residents of Claverton Road West whether (a) they would be in agreement to change the name and (b) what suggestions you have for a new name.

Alternatively should both roads become just Claverton Road and those currently in Claverton Road West just change their numbers? I stress that this idea is very much in its early stages - no decisions have been made one way of the other - now is the time to voice your thoughts on the matter to me on a postcard.

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT IN THE HIGH STREET/MEAD LANE/THE SHALLOWS

I have just been advised that work is due to take place in the next financial year for B&NES from the 1st April 2003. It has been agreed to extend the 20mph beyond the Sailing Club in Mead Lane to The Jolly Sailor Pub.
