Compost converter bins start at **£15 for a 220 litre bin or £18 for a 330 litre bin***. Other types of compost bins and compost accessories are available on the website below.

There were 8 nominations for the 11 seats on Saltford Parish Council. This meant that all 8 people nominated were elected uncontested. These are:



The first weekend of the festival is a very busy one. On Saturday June 11th please turn up at Saltford Hall by 10.00pm for The Lions' Big Breakfast and the chance to see Peter Dando, our 'Village Crier' for the week, ring in the festival. The School Fair is the important event for the afternoon. We are so pleased to have additional links with Barry Rennie and his staff. In the evening Saltford Village Choir will present their Festival Concert.

On Sunday June 12th part of the High Street will be closed from midday to allow for The Old Village Day. The programme is varied and we will welcome Jacob-Rees Mogg as our guest for the afternoon. He will also help with the judging of the Photographic Competition and assessing the entries in The Stove Pipe Hat Race organised by the school.
