

Restoring the balance – The Children's Society working in Saltford



In partnership with Saltford Parish Council and the Parish Plan steering group, The Children's Society has been working to:

- Build Relationships between older and younger people
- Offer Positive Activities over the summer months
- And get to know individuals (young people and adults) better to develop a project for the future, looking at building on the positive experiences people have of living in the village.

This summer we ran a series of activities in Claverton Road West park for young people aged over 10 years, including outdoor art sessions and rounders. This gave us the chance to get to know young people better in an informal way before we move on to developing the project. In addition, we spent time with the residents of Hinton and Iford Close and Wick House to enjoy memories of their youth and to think about the stereotypes we all carry with us about people of different ages.

All of this work is leading us to the next phase of the project where we will:

- Develop conversation groups for all ages to look at the issues of how public space is shared, and feeling safe in Saltford.
- Get to know young people better
- Support the SCAN newsletter to develop a 'youth page' to increase readership. Young people will be at the centre of this project.
- Bring different age groups together to get to know each other better And respond to issues of concern highlighted by the police, PACT and the community.

Our new intergenerational worker will be in post in late September and will take a lead in the Restoring the Balance project, alongside the rest of the team here at The Children's Society.

Launched in 2000, the Family Information Service has 10 years experience of answering queries from local parents, from questions about childcare to starting and moving through school. They keep a wide range of up to date information on registered childcare across BaNES such as nurseries, pre-schools, childminders, after school clubs and parent & toddler groups.

The service is very popular and handles approximately hundreds of requests for information every month. Parent Samantha Williams has used the service on a number of occasions. She said: "The Family Information Service has come to my aid on several occasions - from searching for childcare providers, and then toddler groups in my area to children's music groups and other activities, always with a courteous attitude on the phone or via email. This is a valuable resource for B&NES and we should cherish it."


